Brehman Gregory I., obstetrician-gynecologist, MD, professor of obstetrics and gynecology.

He graduated from the Ivanovo State Medical Institute (after renaming - Medical Academy - IGMA). After clinical residency, target postgraduate (2nd MOLMI them. Pirogov) and Ph.D. degree - teaching, medical and scientific work in Igman. Since 1986, on behalf of the rector organized and headed the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Faculty Postgraduate Medical IGMA for 15 years.

Doctoral dissertation is devoted to the development of theory in medicine at syntropias on example of combined gynecological and extra genital diseases infectious-inflammatory and psychosomatic origin (1990). Subsequently continued study of psychosomatic disorders in obstetrics gynecological practice, one result of which was the monograph "Fibroids cancer: psychosomatic aspects, conservative treatment and prevention "(2000).

Since 1992, began research in prenatal and perinatal psychology and medicine. One result was the development of the wave theory of exchange information between the mother and her unborn child, the award-winning International Society of Prenatal and Perinatal Psychology and Medicine (ISPPM) name Elda Mazochchi (2005).

Total has published more than 200 works, including more than 100 - dedicated to the pre-perinatal psychology. Carried out the translation from English into Russian monographs American psychologist D. Chamberlain "Mind your newborn child "(Moscow: class, 2004, 2005), the monograph "The phenomenon of violence (from home to global): A look from the perspective of pre- and perinatal psychology and medicine "(Haifa, St. Petersburg, 2005), a monograph Greek psychiatrist A. Kafkalides "Knowledge of the Womb. Autopsihodiagnostika with psychedelic drugs" (St. Petersburg: IPTP, 2007), a German psychoanalyst L. Janus "Echoes from the womb. Lasting effect antenatal impressions " (Kiev: TZP "KOMPRINT", 2013).

Served with presentations on pre-perinatal psychology International conferences and congresses International Society of Prenatal and Perinatal Psychology and Medicine - ISPPM (Cracow-1992, Heidelberg-1995, London-1998, Cagliari-2000, Budapest-2002, Heidelberg-2005, Moscow, 2007), as well as numerous conferences and symposia and obstetricians Perinatal Psychology (St. Petersburg in 1997, Ivanovo in 1998, 2000, 2001, Haifa 2006, Patra 2006, Moscow, 1996-2009, Kaunas 2008, Saki 2010, Kharkov 2010, 2011, 2013, Beograd 2011, Kyiv 2010, 2012, Vinnitsa 2010, 2013 and others.).

Examining issues of prenatal psychology has continued in the three candidate graduate theses. Is the founder and first president of the first officially registered in the Russian Association of Perinatal Psychology and Medicine (APPM) Ivanovo Region (1994), and then - Russian interregional MRP in St. Petersburg (1997).

Member of the Advisory Council ISPPM (2002-2008).

Member of the Editorial Board of "The Int. J. of Prenatal & Perinatal Psychology & Medicine" (Heidelberg, Germany) and a member of the Editorial Board of the journal "Journal of Medical Ivanovo Academy "(Ivanovo, Russia).

Chairman of the Dissertation Council for PhD theses on obstetrics and gynecology at the Ivanovo State Medical Academy (1994-2000). Professor Emeritus of the Ivanovo State Medical Academy (2006) and Honorary Head of the Department Igman (2010).

Currently collaborates with the Interdisciplinary Center for Clinical Haifa University of Haifa member of the House of Scientists.
